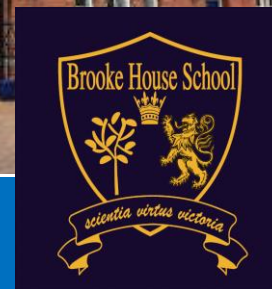

Interhouse Enrichment Curriculum

On Thursday 9th February we held our Interhouse Enrichment Curriculum morning and competition.

Students were split into their house groups and then began working through various activities. The activities had an art focus and were based on The Van Gogh art study which the students worked on last week. Examples of the activities were - Students could choose a piece of artwork and then had to re-create it using Vegetables or sweets. They also used clay or paint to make swirly patterns as Van Gogh used a lot of swirls in his artwork. There was also some maths involved in the mornings activities with squares being used to re-create artwork.



Points were awarded during the morning for team spirit, whole team participation, planning, helping each other, end product and tidying up. The teams worked extremely well together – with older students supporting the younger ones – and they all produced some amazing work in a short period of time. The house captains were outstanding leaders and really motivated their teams. It was a very close competition - the results were as follows;

- 1st Place - Truth (Green) - 81 points
- 2nd Place - Sincerity (Yellow) - 80 points
- 3rd Place - Honesty (Blue) - 79 points
- 4th Place - Respect (Red) - 78 points

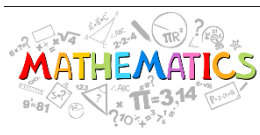


Times Tables Champion

Find the nth term of the sequence below:

6 17 32 51 74

This question was answered by one of our year 10 students.

Their solution to follow next week.

Last week's questions: Using factors find the answers to 35×8 and $114 \div 6$

These questions were answered by one of our year 6 students as follows.

$$\begin{aligned} 35 \times 8 &= 8 \times 7 \times 5 \\ &= 40 \times 7 \\ &= 280 \end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned} 114 \div 6 \\ 114 \div 2 = 57 \\ 57 \div 3 = 19 \end{aligned}$$

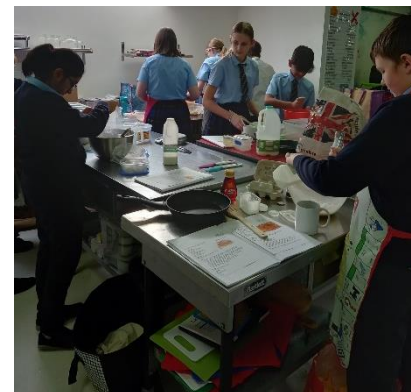

Please find the recipe below as requested by the students so they can make more at home on Tuesday 21st February, which is Shrove Tuesday.

Ingredients for egg free pancakes

330g self-raising flour
1 tsp sugar
1 tbsp baking powder
100ml milk

Method

Put flour, baking powder & sugar in a bowl.
Slowly mix in the milk, whisk if lumpy.
Put oil into a frying pan and heat up, add the mixture to fill the pan. Flip half way through.
Serve with your favourite toppings.
