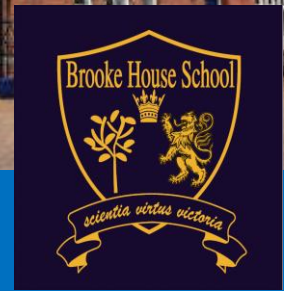


Brooke House School Bulletin

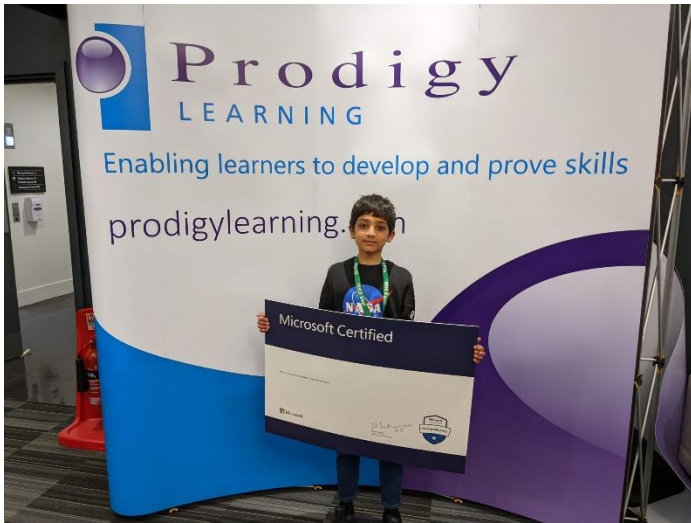

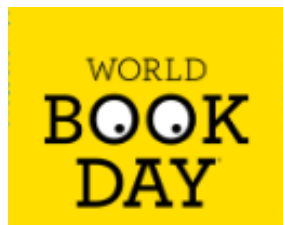
World Maths Day

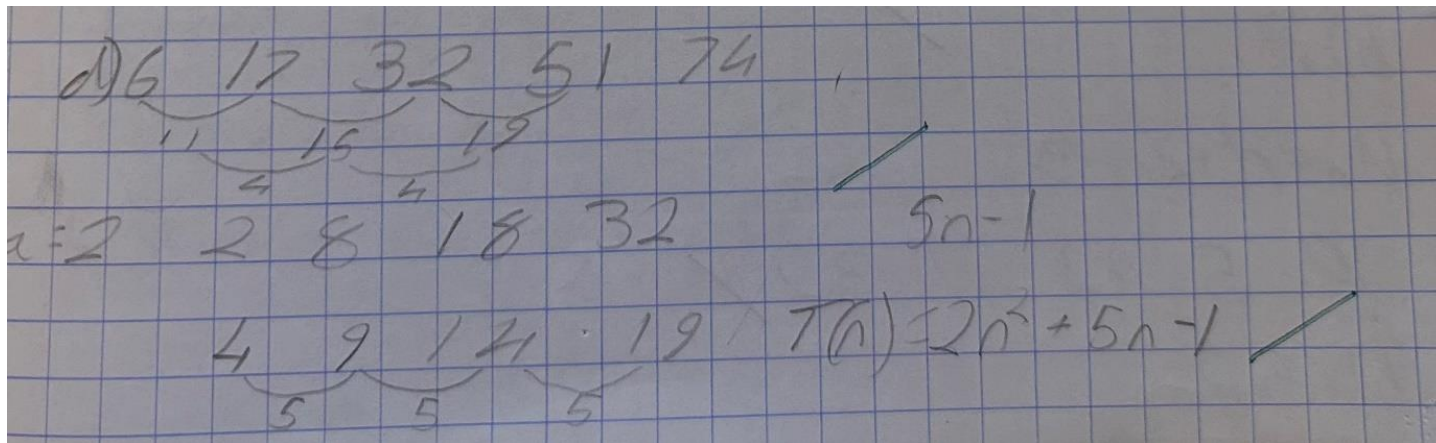
