## Snow Day

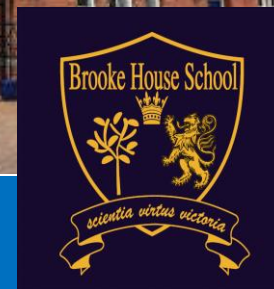
How exciting – well the children thought so....

### Last week's solution
