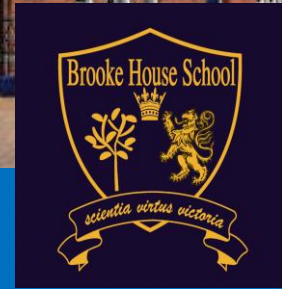


# Brooke House School Bulletin

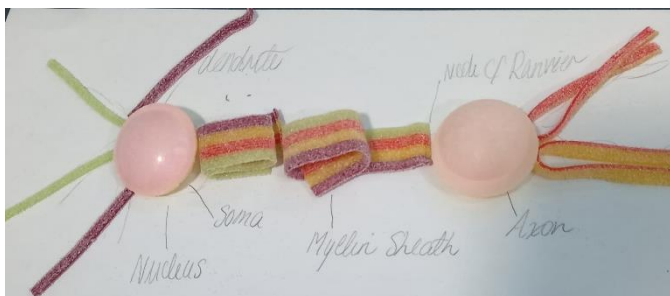
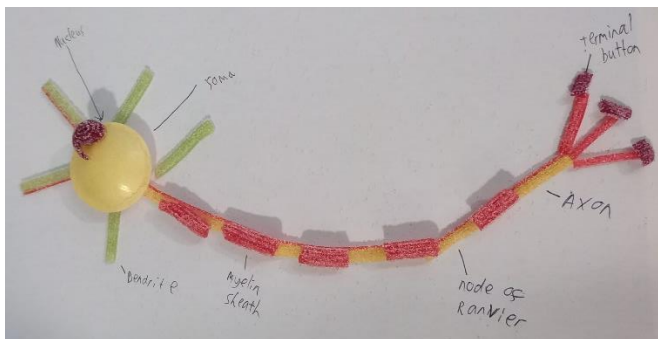

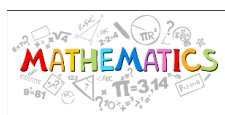
