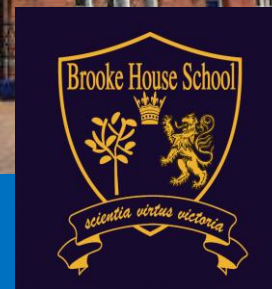


Brooke House School Bulletin

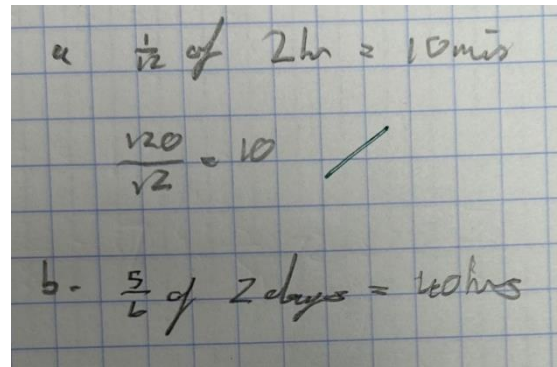
