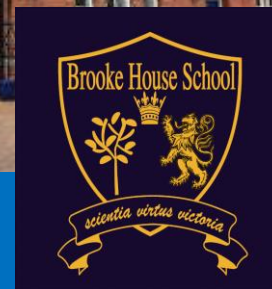

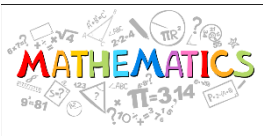


Times Tables Champions

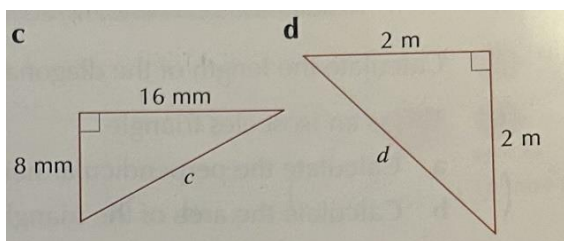
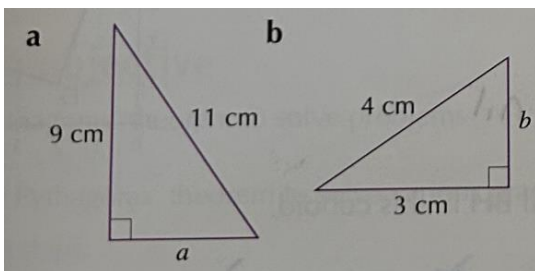

$$\begin{aligned} a) \quad a^2 + 9^2 &= 11^2 \\ a^2 &= 11^2 - 9^2 \\ a^2 &= 40 \\ a &= 6.3 \text{ cm} \checkmark \\ b) \quad b^2 + 3^2 &= 4^2 \\ b^2 &= 4^2 - 3^2 \\ b^2 &= 7 \\ b &= 2.6 \text{ cm} \checkmark \end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned} c) \quad c^2 &= 8^2 + 16^2 \\ c^2 &= 320 \\ c &= 17.9 \text{ mm} \checkmark \\ d) \quad d^2 &= 2^2 + 2^2 \\ d^2 &= 8 \\ d &= 2.8 \text{ m} \checkmark \end{aligned}$$
