

Applications:

Brooke House School is happy to accept students at any time during the school year, subject to availability.

Upon applying for a place at Brooke House the school will arrange a personal tour and a meeting with the Principal so that we can be sure Brooke House is the right school for your child. Thereafter your child will be invited to spend a day with us in school.

Where a child has behavioral issues or learning difficulties, further assessment may be required.

Procedure:

Upon the offer and an acceptance of a place at Brooke House, students will be admitted on completion of the school Registration Form and payment of the non-refundable £75.00 registration fee. A deposit of £300.00 is also required to secure the place. This deposit will be refunded when a student leaves the school and all monies in relation to fees are paid up to date in accordance with the terms and conditions.

Parents/Carers with Legal Parental Responsibility undertake to pay the school fees as set out in our fee schedule in accordance with our Terms and Conditions.
