#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

We believe these standard terms and conditions reflect the custom and practice of private day nurseries.

The rules about notice and payment of fees are designed to promote stability, assist in forward planning and resource of the nursery. Nothing within these terms & conditions affect the parent/ guardian's statutory rights. To enable us to provide and maintain the highest standards of care we require all parents to be aware of, and abide by, the following conditions. To register your child at the nursery, a non refundable registration fee of £75.00 is payable for each child registered. This does not guarantee that a place will be available. All fees are invoiced monthly in advance and are due on the first day of the month to which they relate. Fees will be invoiced to the person's) named on the registration form. Fees are payable during periods of absence from the nursery, including sickness, holidays and public and bank holidays. Fees may be paid by bank transfer, cheque, cash or childcare vouchers. To secure a place the first month's fee must be paid at the time the place is confirmed by the parent or quardian. Once a place at the nursery is confirmed, six weeks written notice is required if you wish to withdraw your child from the nursery or reduce the sessions attended. Fees are payable during the whole of this time, fees are also payable if there is any delay in taking up the places once accepted. Teapots also reserves the right to give you 6 weeks notice to withdraw your child should the need arise. Teapots Nursery School reserves the right to charge interest on late fees at the rate of 2% over the Bank of England rate. For represented cheques a minimum charge of £20.00 per occasion will be applied. Children may be excluded from the nursery if fees remain outstanding beyond 14 days from their due date and the registration terminated. We do not accept responsibility for accidental injury or loss of property. We do maintain those insurance's required by law. Details of these are available from the nursery. Copies of the current Employer's Liability and Public Liability Insurance polices are displayed on the notice boards at the nursery. Where a member of staff, within three months of leaving the employment of Teapots, is employed by a parent/ quardian to care for their child, who was previously registered at the nursery then the parent/quardian will be liable to pay Teapots Nursery School a sum equivalent to three months salary for the employee at the time their employment with Teapots terminated. If your child becomes ill during a nursery session the nursery will contact the parent/ guardian or the emergency contact indicated on the registration form. If your child is from a communicable illness your child should not be brought to nursery until such time as the infection has cleared. Parents/guardians are required to notify the nursery manager if your child is absent from the nursery through sickness. A full copy of the company's infection control policy is available from the nursery. Parents/guardians collecting late children from the nursery will be subject to a surcharge, details of which are published at the nursery. Charges are made for every 10 minutes or part thereof at a rate of £10.00. Parents/quardians should be aware that the nursery has to be vacated by a designated closing time. It is understood that Teapots is under an obligation to report to social services any incident where we consider a child may have been abused or neglected. This may be done without informing the parent or guardian. I am aware that the nursery policies and procedures are available for me to view at anytime. If you are claiming nursery education funding you must ensure your child attends all sessions claimed for in full. If a child's attendance is poor, sessions are regularly missed or a child does not attend the full length of the session then the funding will be withdrawn and you will be liable for the costs of those sessions.
